



GREENKEEPER PRIORITY

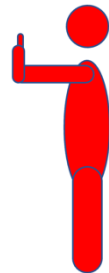
Golfers are expected to wait for staff to acknowledge them and move out of range, **BEFORE** playing a shot that might endanger them.

Greens staff are always vigilant when working on the course and are aware of golfers waiting to play.

A two-step signalling process is followed: -



A hand-signal to acknowledge the golfer and tell them that they must wait.
This will be a single raised hand.



A waving of the hand/arm in a forwards and backwards motion signals the golfer to play.



Please also note the following points: -

If the greenkeeper is within 2 minutes of completing a task, they will finish before moving away.

If the greenkeeper is **NOT** within 2 minutes of completing the task, they will move to a position of safety and wave golfers on.

DO NOT assume a greenkeeper will be able to hear or react to a shout of "FORE!"

A position of safety includes parking at the edge of the fairway and facing away from golfers.

All golfers and greens staff have been provided with this information.

ANY subsequent near misses, resulting from impatient golfers will be reported and pursued by the club.

This is a Zero Tolerance Policy.
